**Methodology**

1. Visit to MPC corporate offices in Belgrade
2. Interviews with relevant personnel of MPC properties
3. Review of internal and external documentary evidence produced by MPC Properties
4. Audit of reported data, including a detailed review of a sample of data against source data
5. Review of MPC properties systems for collection, aggregation, analysis and internal verification and review of environmental data.

**Our conclusion**

Based on the process and procedures conducted, there is no evidence that the environmental data disclosure, including energy, water, waste, are not materially correct or are not a fair representation of the of the data and information.
